The program called for a modest, single story wheelchair-accessible home in an older neighborhood. The design included passive sustainable qualities such as large shade-producing porch and vegetation, breezeways, and overhangs calculated to shade windows during the hottest months. The dormer windows open not to an attic or second floor, but to the vaulted ceiling of the main living space, filled with natural light.
